Resume and Interview Session Presenter: Students who do not have a resume will be directed to receive 20-minute presentations that alternate every half hour between *Resume Essentials* or *Putting Your Best Self Forward*. Presentation material is provided. We need **4 volunteers**.

Student Check & Line Volunteers: We need **8 volunteers** to greet incoming students and direct them into the mock interview or resume/interview session area.
